

A reminder from the Lamoille Valley Rail Trail website:

Overnight parking is permitted on a short-term basis at the State Park & Rides with permission from AOT. **Overnight camping in vehicles is NOT permitted.**

Respect for the adjacent landowners includes accessing the trail only from these designated access points and not along private driveways, farm crossings, or other trail crossings that do not otherwise connect to public facilities. **Camping on the trail right of way or at trailheads is prohibited.**

Commercial Campgrounds and State Parks within eight miles of the Lamoille Valley Rail Trail

Most of these places will be uphill from the rail trail, which is in the valley.
